

**Directions to Festival Site  
at Edison First Aid Squad Hall, Edison, NJ**

**From the Garden State Parkway heading South:**

Take exit 131. At top of exit ramp, turn right to take route 27 (Lincoln Highway) South, turn right at light just after Metro Park Railroad station onto North Wood Avenue (County road 649). Go through first light at Oak Tree Road and go 0.9 miles and turn left at second light onto New Dover Road. Go 1 mile and pass the James Madison Primary school on right, then turn right at Edison First Aid Squad sign into 848 New Dover Road, just before the Fire Station. Parking is at rear of building, first lane is reserved for first aid squad vehicles, park only in lanes at rear.

**From the Garden State Parkway heading North:**

Take Garden State Parkway North to exit 131. At top of exit ramp, turn right to take route 27 (Lincoln Highway) South, turn right at light just after Metro Park Railroad station onto North Wood Avenue (County road 649). Go through first light at Oak Tree Road and go 0.9 miles and turn left at second light onto New Dover Road. Go 1 mile and pass the James Madison Primary school on right, then turn right at Edison First Aid Squad sign into 848 New Dover Road, just before the Fire Station. Parking is at rear of building, first lane is reserved for first aid squad vehicles, park only in lanes at rear.

**From the New Jersey Turnpike heading North or South:**

Take exit 11 to the Garden State Parkway North to exit 131. Follow directions for Garden State Parkway North.

**Note: the most convenient airport is Newark (EWR) which is 15 minutes from site. Laguardia (LGA) & JFK are 70 minutes, allow for bad traffic.**

**Closest railroad station is Metro Park, NJ, which is approximately a 10 minute taxi ride to the Danceathon.**
